As a collective of business owners and leaders, elected officials, city staff and leaders, and community advocates, the Happy Valley Business Alliance (HVBA) aims to be the pivotal advocacy group for our Happy Valley business community. In order to become this pivotal advocacy group, in 2024 we made the following strides.

- Seek Membership Voice and Input. We started in January 2024, by reviewing membership input from our first ever membership survey. This input revealed the importance of meeting structure and time, as well as diversity within the membership and its board. It also drove the board in its decision-making considering accessibility, visibility, and connection.
- Events Access and Visibility. The HVBA became a city sponsor, sponsoring the Youth Entrepreneur Fair in the Concerts in the Valley, the 4th of July Festivities, as well as sponsoring the Dog Races in Oktoberfest. As a community Partner, the HVBA's desire of connection is evident in its fiduciary commitment to our membership and community. In addition, members were provided with the opportunity to sign up and be visible at each of these events.
- North Clackamas School District. A free, public education is the ultimate equalizer in our society. As a result, it was imperative to extend an olive branch to our school district and offer them a voice at our meetings. We are grateful for the monthly school updates at our Membership Meetings and look forward to the continual transparency.

- More Outreach. With the intent to stimulate involvement and visibility, a subcommittee was created with four members. Our focus has been to enhance our visibility on our social media platforms, as well as creating a monthly newsletter to connect our community. More is to come!
- Ribbon Cutting Ceremonies. New and established businesses are welcome to schedule a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony with the City and the HVBA. With approximately ten ribbon cutting ceremonies in 2024, the events provided community exposure and familiarity to the businesses. You can schedule your Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for 2025! Our plan is to continue the same rhythm of 2024 and build onto it in 2025. We are grateful for each of our members and expect the same level of commitment.
